The Sermon on the Mount: Firm Foundations

Matthew 7:24-29

Matthew 7:24 (NIV) "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock."

We all experience the same stormy weather.

- Matthew 7:25 (NIV) "The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock."
- Matthew 7:27 (NIV) "The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."
 - Rain: The <u>circumstances</u> that won't <u>let up</u>.
 - Floods: The worries that won't shut up.
 - Psalm 69:1–3 (NIV) "Save me, O God, for the waters have come up to my neck. ² I sink in the miry depths, where there is no foothold. I have come into the deep waters; the floods engulf me. ³ I am worn out calling for help; my throat is parched. My eyes fail, looking for my God."
 - Wind: The <u>pressure</u> that won't <u>lighten up</u>.

We do not all weather our storms the same.

- 1. A Firm Foundation = Doing what Jesus said to do.
 - Matthew 7:24–25 (NIV) "Therefore everyone who <u>hears these words of mine</u> and <u>puts them into</u> <u>practice</u> is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock."
 - James 1:22 (NIV) "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."
- 2. A Flimsy Foundation = Disregarding what Jesus said to do.
 - Matthew 7:26–27 (NIV) "But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."
 - Proverbs 22:3 (NIV) "A prudent man sees danger and takes refuge, but the simple keep going and suffer for it."
 - Psalm 119:105 (NIV) "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path."
 - Matthew 7:28–29 (NIV) "When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at His teaching, ²⁹ because He taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law."
