# **Getting Reconnected**

Mark 1:40-45

### A condition can disconnect me.

Mark 1:40a (NIV) "A man with leprosy came to Him..."

Matthew 8:1–2 (NIV) "When He came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed Hm. <sup>2</sup> A man with leprosy came and knelt before Him..."

Luke 5:12a (NIV) "...a man came along who was covered with leprosy."



#### A conversation can reconnect me.

Mark 1:40–42 (NIV) "A man with leprosy came to Him and begged Him on his knees, "If you are willing, you can make me clean." <sup>41</sup> Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out His hand and touched the man. "I am willing," He said. "Be clean!" <sup>42</sup> Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured."

Isaiah 64:6 (NIV) "All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags..."

### Sin & Leprosy

- Both begin within.
- Both are painless at first.
- Both grow slowly.
- Both numb the senses.
- Both cause decay and deformity.
- Both affect relationships.

1 John 1:8–9 (NIV) "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

## A choice can disconnect others.

Mark 1:43–45a (NIV) "Jesus sent him away at once with a strong warning: 44 "See that you don't tell this to anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." 45 Instead he went out and began to talk freely, spreading the news. As a result, Jesus could no longer enter a town openly but stayed outside in lonely places."
