1 Corinthians 10:31-11:1


 Romans 7:19 (NLT) "I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway."


I know I should glorify God, but sometimes I ignore Him.

 1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV) "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."

 Matthew 5:16 (ESV) "... let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

I know I should reveal Christ, but sometimes I conceal Him.

 1 Corinthians 10:32–33 (NIV) "Do not cause anyone to stumble, whether Jews, Greeks or the church of God—<sup>33</sup> even as I try to please everybody in every way. For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved."

 Galatians 3:28 (NIV) "There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

I know I should exemplify Christ, but sometimes I distort Him.

 1 Corinthians 11:1 (NIV) "Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ."

 John 3:30 (NIV) "He must become greater; I must become less."
